The AMP program provides scholarship-funded training to qualified individuals. Upon completion of the program successful applicants will be Certified Production Technicians.

Advanced manufacturing thrives in south central Indiana. Everything from lifesaving medical devices, automotive components, aerospace products, consumer goods, and industrial machinery roll off production lines and are then distributed to global markets around the world.

The Certified Production Technician is an eight-week (160 hour) program that results in certifications in the following areas:

- o Safety
- o Quality & Measurement
- o Manufacturing & Production
- o Maintenance Awareness

The program will also include a visit to local manufacturers, assistance with interview skills and resume writing, and other useful tools to get you started on your Advanced Manufacturing career!
